12 Section 3. The act is amended by adding a section to read:
13 Section 1727-K. Temporary Restrictions on Special Funds.--
14 (a) Notwithstanding section 1726-K, after the effective date of
15 this section, no department, commission, agency, office or
16 authority of the Governor or the Commonwealth shall enter into
17 any contract which would require the expenditure of money from
18 the following special funds:

19 (1) Agricultural Conservation Easement Purchase Fund.
20 (2) Ben Franklin Technology Development Authority Fund.
21 (3) Compulsive and Problem Gambling Treatment Fund.
22 (4) Conservation District Fund.
23 (4) Energy Development Fund.
24 (5) Environmental Education Fund.
25 (6) Environmental Stewardship Fund.
26 (7) Historical Preservation Fund.
27 (8) Industrial Development Fund.
28 (9) Justice Reinvestment Fund.
29 (10) Keystone Recreation, Park and Conservation Fund.
30 (11) Minority Business Development Fund.
31 (12) PA eHealth Partnership Fund.

1 (13) PA Infrastructure Bank.

2 (14) Recycling Fund.

3 (15) Solid Waste-Resource Recovery Development Fund.

4 (16) Highway Beautification Fund.

5 (b) This section shall expire on the day after either of the
6 following are terminated by executive order, proclamation or
7 operation of law, whichever is later:

8 (1) The proclamation of disaster emergency issued by the
9 Governor on March 6, 2020, published at 50 Pa.B. 1644 (March 21,
10 2020).

11 (2) A declaration of disaster emergency related to the novel
12 coronavirus known as "COVID-19" that is issued after March 6,
13 2020.

14 Section 4. This act shall take effect as follows:

15 (1) This section and the addition of section 1727-K of
16 the act shall take effect immediately.

17 (2) The remainder of this act shall take effect in 60
18 days.
